

Buiksloterham (BSH), on the northern side of the IJ, once was the site of Amsterdam's most polluting industries. Now it's being transformed into one of the most sustainable areas. The strength of BSH is the mix of living with small industry. Instead of further expelling business outside the city and creating yet another residential area, Buiksloterham is choosing to mix both activities.

BSH is known for its self-build projects and its unconventional buildings. The inhabitants, the local government and start-ups all work together to create zero-energy and sustainable buildings. BSH wants to become a circular neighbourhood, living by the motto 'learning by doing'.





FIND EXTRA STOPS

What used to be a predominant working area is now rapidly transforming into a vibrant living and working area. This green neighbourhood is now known for its redevelopment projects, self-build, hotels and small harbour, but the past is still tangible through the characteristic monuments of the old Zuidergasfabriek (gas works).


Standing out from the crowd is the former prison on the other side of the train track being demolished. Designed by OMA, the Bajes Kwartier wants to be a testing ground for new forms of circular use of materials and climate-neutral building. Sustainability is of importance for all of Amstelkwartier.

FIND EXTRA STOPS

While Plan Zuid and Buitenveldert were designed as urban extensions for newly acquired territory, the Zuidas is situated on existing Amsterdam territory that overlaps with parts of these two older plans. From around 1975, large offices began to establish here, close to Station Zuid, which opened in 1978.


Within the framework of the 1998 Zuidas Master Plan, a hypermodern high-density mixed urban district is now being developed. At the same time, the aim is to create a connecting zone between the adjacent city districts, for example by the means of the Zuidasdok megaproject. Recently completed offices allow the Zuidas to develop into an exceptional urban centre.

Houthaven is a new neighbourhood situated in the West of Amsterdam. The new district will be built on seven islands, situated after what used to be the headlands in the former harbour. The islands all have their own architectural themes. The neighbourhood will have a small-scale urban, sustainable character and will accommodate approximately 2.700 homes. To connect the Spaarndammerbuurt and Zeeheldenbuurt, traffic is guided through a tunnel with a new park above.

The icon for the new district is the more than 80 meters high Pontsteiger, built on the tip of the ferry landing. In the nearby Minervahaven a transformation is taking place from a port to an urban business centre, fashion industry, hotels and restaurants.
